HOW DO I REDEEM CME HOURS?

- · Answer questions with the required passing percentage (required percentage is course-specific)
- Click "My CME/CE", then click the Claim Credits button
- · Fill out and submit the form and evaluation
- Printable PDF certificate will be generated with the number of completed hours
- The certificate will be emailed to the email address provided

HOW DO I PRINT MY PDF CERTIFICATE?

In addition to the copy that was sent to you via email, we store copies of your CME certificates on our website! You can download the PDF of your certificate directly from our site.

- Log into boardvitals.com/app and go to the Dashboard.
- On the top of the page, select My CME/CE.
- From here, select the Claimed CME tab (located on the far-right side of the page).
- Select the certificate you would like to get a copy of by pressing Download.

WHAT HAPPENS TO EARNED CME CREDITS IF I DELETE MY EXAMS OR MY SUBSCRIPTION EXPIRES?

Credits you have earned will remain in your account until you redeem them. If you delete your exams, it will reset the questions but credits that you earned and did not redeem will still be available. (Note: you cannot earn credits twice for questions already completed) If your subscription expires, any credits already earned will be available to redeem.

HOW ARE CME CREDITS CALCULATED?

CME credits are accumulated by the number of unique questions you answer. This number is determined by the overall number of questions within the question bank, but on average it takes about 20 - 25 questions to earn 1 CME hour/1 MOC point. Credits are calculated as questions are answered and you receive a passing percentage. The required percentage to pass is determined by each individual board. Please refer to the course description.

HOW ARE MY CME CREDITS AND MOC POINTS SUBMITTED?

Courses that are eligible for MOC with ABIM, ABPath and ABP will be submitted to PARS within 45 days of completion. PARS is the national data repository. Preventive Medicine MOC credit hours will be submitted to the ABPM board quarterly. All other CME credits (non-MOC) must be self-reported. Please consult each specific board's website for reporting instructions.

WHY DO YOU NEED MY BOARD ID # FOR CME?

We comply with the latest electronic submission guidelines, which require a Board Identifier and accurate date of birth. Note that if the information doesn't match, we will not be able to submit your certificates.

WHAT PERCENTAGE OF ACCURACY IS NEEDED TO QUALIFY FOR CME?

The percentage accuracy required varies by question bank although the average accuracy rate is approximately 70%. Questions can be corrected as you go through the test bank to achieve your specialty CME requirements. Please refer to the course for additional information.

HOW MANY HOURS CAN I EARN?

Earned CME hours will depend on your specialty. It varies by question bank, but the average is about 20 questions taken per CME hour earned. Once you have redeemed the maximum number of MOC points available in a question bank, you cannot earn any more MOC credit from that bank.
