Bibliographic Citations


Citations for use in research papers can be generated by using the Bibliographic Citations feature at the bottom of every STAT!Ref Online document. You can export citations suitable for use in a number of citation services as well as coping the citation directly to paste into your document.

- Download EndNote Citation File
- Download RefWorks Citation File
- Export directly to RefWorks
- Download IRS Citation File
- Download Bib text Citation File
- Highlight and copy (Ctrl-C) the plain text citation




